INJURIES AS PRESENT AT TIME OF POSTMORTEM EXAMINATION-

1. Diffuse swelling seen over at the nape of Neck. On dissection, hematoma seen over paraspinal muscles. On F/D muscle hematoma seen over prevertebral fascia. On F/D fracture of C2 Cervical vertebra seen along with antemortem hematoma. On F/D Spinal cord is contused and oedematous at the level of C2 cervical vertebra and above and below the level of cervical vertebrae fracture.
2. Stitched wound of size 2 cm present over mid frontal region with surrounding abrasion of size 2x1 cm with black hard scab fallen off at periphery. On dissection underlying subscalp haematoma dark black in color over right FFP region. On F/D dura found intact and tense. Brain found edematous and soft, multiple petechial hemorrhages found in bilateral cerebral cortex of FTPO lobes and mid brain.

Note: - All Above Mentioned Injuries Are Antemortem in Nature and their Duration is within 1-2 weeks Prior To Death.

OPINION:

In my opinion cause of death is SHOCK brought about as a result of Ante-mortem Cervical Spine Injury no. 1 and its consequences as mentioned above in this PMR, which is sufficient to cause death in ordinary course of nature.
